Your New DeKalb County Deferred Compensation Plan

Your plan is transitioning to DeKalb County's Deferred Compensation plan with Nationwide

Following a thorough analysis, DeKalb County has decided to transfer participants to the DeKalb County Deferred Compensation Plan administered by Nationwide.

Starting August 11, 2017, DeKalb County Deferred Compensation participants previously administered under the GEBCorp and ICMA plans will be transitioned to the DeKalb County Deferred Compensation Plan with Nationwide. The transition period will be as short and seamless as possible. Bringing participants from GEBCorp and ICMA into a single deferred compensation plan allows us to deliver:

-  Comprehensive retirement planning tools
-  Website customized for the County's employees
-  Responsive, local Plan service
-  Low cost funds

About the transition

Participants enrolled in plans not administered by Nationwide will have their account transferred into a new account with Nationwide. The consolidation process will require a transition that includes a short **black-out period**, during which participants will have limited access to their retirement account, while their assets remain invested. As you will read on the following pages, the transition period will be short and as seamless as possible.



Please read this brochure carefully, so that you can make informed decisions about your participation in the Plan.

Investment Option Updates

Your current funds will be mapped as displayed in the Fund Mapping Letter you will receive in the mail.

NOTE ABOUT THE PLUS FUND: All Plus Fund Assets will remain with ICMA through February 2018. If you are 100% invested in the Plus Fund and are taking a distribution, you will continue to receive your payout from ICMA through this date.

After February 2018, your Plus Fund assets will transfer to the Nationwide Guaranteed Fund. This transfer will be featured on your First Quarter 2018 statement mailed in April 2018.

ICMA Blackout Period*	August 1 after 4 p.m. ET through August 11 at 8:00 a.m. ET	No transactions can be accepted or processed. *During the Blackout Period, your money stays active in the market and you can still view your account at your previous provider. If you anticipate making a change to your account, please do so prior to 4:00 p.m. ET on August 1, 2017.
	August 9	ICMA and GEBCorp. accounts and assets will be transferred to Nationwide and mapped as explained in the detailed Fund Investment Letter.
	August 11	Your DeKalb County Deferred Compensation Plan account will be fully active at 8 a.m. ET.

Effective August 11, 2017, you can access your account with your favorite web-enabled device. Approximately 5 working days prior to the August 11, 2017 transition date, you will receive a correspondence from Nationwide with your new account number. Use this number on or after August 11, 2017 to establish an online account (including establishing a username and password) and sign up for eDelivery.



As you set up access to your account online and by phone, you will be asked to use your social security number, date of birth and account number. To protect your privacy, use your unique account number received from Nationwide.
